

**Call for Nominations:
UC Management Development Program (MDP)**

Application Deadline: September 22, 2017 (5:00 pm)

UC Davis Talent Management and Development is pleased to offer the UC Management Development Program (MDP) in October-November 2017. Although the program cost is approximately \$550 per participant, Talent Management and Development will be covering the cost for all selected participants.

We invite you to nominate up to three participants for the upcoming program. Thirty participants from across both the Davis campus and UC Davis Health will be selected from those nominated. Please provide your nominations by September 22, 2017.

Description

MDP is designed to enhance and strengthen UC manager capabilities in four core competencies – People Management, Employee Engagement, Influence, and Change Leadership. The program is intended for managers who manage other supervisors or leads and/or manage complex programs or projects. UC Office of the President and a consortium of training and performance improvement professionals throughout UC worked with industry leaders in talent management and leadership development to create four modules of content. The curriculum includes topics and discussions relevant to the demands facing UC managers. Each module will be held from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. alternating between the Davis and Sacramento campuses. Lunch will be provided.

- **Module 1: People Management – October 17:** Redefine the role of manager and leader who encourages and guides employees, advances teamwork, inspires trust, and optimizes results.
- **Module 2: Employee Engagement – October 30:** Create a workplace environment that promotes employee engagement and development.
- **Module 3: Exercising Influence – November 6:** Practice influence strategies to engage others in a way that is motivating and makes things happen.
- **Module 4: Leading Change and Managing Transition - November 13:** Lead, guide and motivate others through organizational change and individual transition.

UC People Management Conference (August 7-8, 2018, UCLA Luskin Center): The regional conference gives participants opportunity to share and apply learning with peers from other UC locations. Those who complete the four MDP modules will be invited to participate and are strongly encouraged to attend.
